KYIVAN RUS 9th-12th centuries Borders and names most THE MAP OF PRINCIPALITIES of the principalities of Kyivan Rus (IX – XIII centuries) **OF KYIVAN RUS IN 1054–1132** had changed several times **PRINCIPALITIES** In 10th-3th centuries population of Kyivan Rus was 4,500,000— Novhorod Principality was ruled by sons of the Kvivan Rus divided into principalities – **Great Prince of Kyiv** autonomous territorial 7,900,000 people entities. Power in it belonged to one military and political leader (prince). It was inherited. KYIVAN RUS – a medieval feudal state centered in Kviv that existed from the end of the 9th to the middle of the 12th century. At the time of its greatest power, it stretched from the Baltic Sea in the north to the Black Sea in the south, and from the headwaters of the Wisla Riverin the west to the Taman Peninsula in the east.

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS IN HISTORY OF KYIVAN RUS

In 882 Prophetic Oleh had captured Kyiv and proclaimed it his capital -«let it be the mother of Rus cities»
